Care & Installation of Coloured Products

When handled, stored and installed correctly, coloured profiles will remain 'fit for purpose' throughout the guarantee period.

Handling & Storage

- Coloured products should be stored internally away from direct sunlight in their protective sleeving until just before installation.
- Never store coloured products externally or on top of vans for any length of time as heat distortion may occur.

Installation

- Freefoam recommends the use of Plastops plastic-headed pins and nails for the installation of roofline products. Fixing centres vary but should never exceed 600mm for white profiles, 300mm for black profiles, and 400mm for other coloured and woodgrain profiles.
- Products should not be installed where ambient temperatures are likely to exceed 40 degrees Celsius, such as in close proximity to boiler flues or where there is reflected or radiated solar or other sources of heat. They should only be installed when the external air temperature is between 0 and 30 degrees Celsius. The thermal movement that occurs between day and night, sun and cloud, winter and summer should be allowed for as described in the installation recommendations.
- · Hollow rigid products should be installed only in areas shaded from direct sunlight such as soffits, porch ceilings, internal cladding, etc. Hollow rigid profiles are not guaranteed for external cladding applications.
- Remove the protective film immediately after installation.
- General installation guidelines are outlined in our Technical & Specification Manual (call your local number at the back of this leaflet for a copy or download from www.freefoam.com).


